

1 LOVING JESUS

MEMORY VERSE:

Acts 13:38-39

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of kids church kids should:

Recognise that as we come to know Jesus we'll grow to be more like him.

Note: Outcome in **bold** is most important and for all age groups. Older age groups will be capable of achieving the other outcomes while younger age groups may not.

Jesus! Jesus No 1

STORY TIME

Luke 24:13-35

It was 3 days after Jesus was crucified. The word had got around that Jesus' body was missing from the tomb. Most of Jesus' followers weren't sure what was happening.

Two of Jesus' followers (Cleopas and a friend) were on a 2-3 hour walk to a village outside Jerusalem and were discussing what had happened.

Jesus joined them and asked what they were discussing. But they did not recognise Him. They told Jesus how confused they were about what had happened.

Jesus told them they must not have understood the message of the Old Testament. (The New Testament, the part that tells the life story of Jesus and what happened after that, hadn't been written yet.)

Jesus then explained how the Old Testament of the Bible, right from the start, was telling the story of Jesus, why He had to come and suffer, and what was going to happen to Him. He showed them how the Old Testament told that Jesus would come to earth, die to take the penalty for our sin, and rise again.

It was only when they reached their destination and sat down to have a meal with Jesus that they recognised who He was. They hurried back to Jerusalem and told the rest of the disciples what had happened. Then Jesus appeared to all of the disciples and explained to them that the Old Testament told the story of all that Jesus was going to do, and how people from all around the world would hear about Him and be forgiven.

As the disciples got to understand the whole message of Jesus, they became better at telling other people about Him. But something else happened. They came to know and understand Jesus better, and they became more like Him.

As we trust Jesus and learn more from the Bible about Him, we can grow to understand Him better and be more like Him too.

Week 1

Footprints to Jesus (group craft) (Exploring God's Promises, p. 64-65)

Materials:

- Foot prints copied or traced on coloured paper
- Glue, scissors, pencils, blue tac
- Copies of the prophecies
- Large copy of the SMS

Directions:

- Trace and cut out feet shapes
- Have the children decorate their footprint
- Cut out prophecies & glue one on each foot

Use:

- Combine all the feet for the group craft
- On the wall in the classroom, blue tac the SMS high on the wall.
- Then blue tac the feet 'walking' towards the SMS

We gather together at church because of Jesus

4 LOVING LOST PEOPLE | CONNECTING WITH JESUS

Jesus wants people to be saved so we should too

5 **LOVING LOST PEOPLE** | GROWING WITH JESUS

We meet together in growth groups to help each other learn about Jesus

6 **LOVING LOST PEOPLE** | SERVING JESUS

The church is like a body, God wants us to work together to help people know Jesus

7 **LOVING TO GIVE** | GIVING EVERYTHING TO JESUS

Because Jesus has given us everything we should give our lives to serve Jesus

8 **LOVING TO GIVE |** SHARING THE GOOD NEWS OF JESUS

Because Jesus has given us such good news we should do all we can to share to good news with people everywhere

9 **LOVING TO GIVE** | SENDING THE GOOD NEWS OF JESUS

Jesus commands us to tell people everywhere the good news about him
