

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GETTING INTO THE WORD



1 Samuel

Every week we are giving you the challenge of getting through 1 Samuel to be finished by the end of this year. It is an exciting book, packed full of drama, war, friendship, hatred, and the ever present power of God.

BACKGROUND: 1 Samuel comes after Judges which ends, "everyone did what was right in his own eyes" (Jud. 17:6, 21:25). Remember the downward spiral? Now we follow Israel and their transition of leadership from judges to kings.

CHARACTERS: Samuel, Saul , David and God (the main character)

CHALLENGE FOR THE KEEN BEANS: See if you can spot some similarities and differences between the stories you read in 1 Samuel and the stories you can find in Luke.

HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

COME TO GOD

Worship him for his power and majesty. Give your feelings and needs to God. Ask for his Holy Spirit to help you understand and respond to what you're about to read.

WEEK 1

The birth of Samuel

- DAY 1 1:1-11

- **DAY 4** 2:1-11
- What similarities are there to the birth story of Samuel and the birth story of Jesus?

READ

- 1. What is the CONTEXT?
- 2. What else can you OBSERVE? (God, Others, You)
- 3. What could it MEAN?
- 4. How can you APPLY it to your life?

TALK TO GOD

Thank God for his word. Tell him what you've learnt.

Ask for his guidance to be with you today.

Try find a key thought or phrase for the day. Maybe even share it!

- DAY 3 9:15-21
- DAY 4 9:22-27
- Seems OK?

Saul made king

- **DAY 4** 10:20-26
- God is with Saul to begin with. What do some people still doubt about?

LUKE 2:41-52

- What was he doing?
- What were the teachers amazed by?
- How did Jesus respond to his parents when they found him?
- What do you think he meant by he "had to be"?
- What special relationship does this point to?
- How does Jesus continue to relate to his earthly parents?
- How does this obedience relate to his relationship with his heavenly Father?
- How does Jesus eventually open up that special relationship to us all?

APPLICATION

- What does it feel like to have a heavenly Father?
- Do you feel you have this special relationship?
- How does Jesus help us relate to our heavenly Father?
- How does this relationship effect the way we relate to our earthly parents?

BIG IDEA

Jesus as a boy reveals his special relationship with his heavenly Father. A relationship we can all now share.


